

The Fruit of the Spirit

1 Corinthians 12:7-10 *To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. For to one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.*

Galatians 5:22–23a *“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control...”*

Genesis 1:12 *“every fruit tree should yield fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself.”*

Fruit of the Spirit: *love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.*

Galatians 5:22–23a

- joy is love rejoicing
- peace is love resting
- longsuffering is love forbearing
- kindness is love serving others
- goodness is love seeking the best for others
- faithfulness is love keeping its promises
- gentleness is love ministering to the hurts of others
- self-control is love in control

2 Peter 1:5-8 *For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love. For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they keep you from being ineffective or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.*

Luke 16:10 *“One who is faithful in a very little (the secular) is also faithful in much (the spiritual), and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much.”*

2 Timothy 3:16-17 *All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work.*

Luke 8:15 *“those who, hearing the word, hold it fast in an honest and good heart, and bear fruit with patience.”*

2 Timothy 1:7 *“for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.”*

Matthew 5:44 *“bless those who curse [us], do good to those who hate [us], and pray for those who spitefully use [us] and persecute [us].”*

Luke 23:34 *“Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do.”*

Acts 7:60 *“Lord, do not charge them with this sin.”*

1 Corinthians 9:22 *“became all things to all men, that [he] might by all means save some.”*

Philippians 3:12-14 *Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.*
